

SITE NOTICE WESTMEATHCOUNTYCOUNCIL

In accordance with the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended (Part XI) and Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended (Part 8), Westmeath County Council hereby state that this Authority proposes to carry out development as described hereunder:-

Location of proposed development: - Áras An Chontae, Mount Street, Mullingar, County Westmeath, N91 FH4N.

Nature and extent of proposed development: - The works being undertaken at the above address will consist of the following:

The erection of mid-size photovoltaic (PV) arrays on the roof area above the administrative offices at Áras An Chontae, Mount Street, Mullingar and associated works. The proposal will comprise of solar modules on a 10° mounting system which will be connected to 3 phase inverters.

These works are located within the curtilage of 2 (no.) protected structures; former prison Governor's House and adjacent buildings, Mullingar Gaol (County Buildings) RPS Reference Number 019 089 and Site of Mullingar Gaol (County Buildings) RPS Reference Number 019 090 and are contained within an Architectural Conservation Area.
