

## PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED) (PART XI) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, 2001 (AS AMENDED) (PART 8)

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the requirements of the above Act and Regulations that Westmeath County Council proposes to undertake the following works:

## Outdoor Recreation Infrastructure Scheme (ORIS) for Carn Park Link Trail at Baylin, Co. Westmeath

The works are to develop a complete leisure route, utilising both the Baylin Bog Trail and Carn Park Forest Walk spanning c.6.5km in length by undertaking the following: -

- Improvements to the existing facilities along the Baylin Bog Leisure Trail;
- Improved directional signs and 'way-finding' signage along the public roads directing users to the trail;
- To complete an active travel loop from the village of Baylin by developing linkage to the Baylin Bog northern access and Western access points;
- Linking the Baylin Bog Trail and Carn Park Forest Walk by developing a 350m r aised boardwalk;
- Providing a safe pedestrian link between the two access points of the Carn Park Forest Walk, along the L-5435 to the East of Carn Park;
- Carrying out all ancillary site works.

The proposed scheme has undergone **Appropriate Assessment Screening** under the Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC) and screening for **Ecological Impact Assessment** under the CIEEM (2010) and EPA guidelines (EPA 2002).

Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice, may apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the proposed development would be likely to have a significant effect on the environment.
