NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF PUBLIC ROADS

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993 and Section 180 of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended), Westmeath County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to consider the making of a declaration that all roads within the following named residential estates be made public roads:

1. Glenmore Wood, Mullingar (171 units)
2. Highfield, Mullingar (15 units)
3. Gairdín Beag, Rathwire (6 units)
4. Rathgowan Wood & Park, Mullingar (40 units)

Maps showing the roads proposed to be made public may be inspected from Tuesday 6 July 2021 to Wednesday 4 August 2021 (inclusive) during normal office hours (in line with Covid-19 arrangements), at the offices of Westmeath County Council, Áras an Chontae, Mount Street, Mullingar.
