Notice is hereby given in accordance with the requirements of the above Regulations that Westmeath County Council proposes to undertake the following works:

Extension of Northern cycle route from Levington to Scragh Bog Carpark

The development will consist of the extension to an existing cycle route at Levington, Mullingar to Scragh Bog Carpark and the upgrading and extension of the existing carpark at the entrance to Scragh Bog, to include the following:

- Provision of off-road cycleway over a distance of circa 380 metres through Council owned lands which lie adjacent to the L-1773 at Levington, Mullingar.
- Provision of “Shared Space” signage along the local roads L-5706 and L-5708 linking to the carpark at Scragh Bog.
- Upgrading, expansion and resurfacing of existing carpark at the entrance to Scragh Bog.

Written submissions or observations received will form part of a statutory report to be presented to a meeting of Westmeath County Council and will form part of a public document. The information contained in submissions may be available for public inspection, to be published on the Council’s website and available at the Council’s public counter.
