

## PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 AS AMENDED (PART XI) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 AS AMENDED (PART 8) ERECTION OF MID-SIZE PHOTOVOLTAIC (PV) ARRAYS ON THE ROOF AREA ABOVE THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES AT ÁRAS AN CHONTAE, MOUNT STREET, MULLINGAR.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the requirements of the above Act and Regulations, that Westmeath County Council proposes to undertake the following development:

The erection of mid-size photovoltaic (PV) arrays on the roof area above the administrative offices at Áras an Chontae, Mount Street, Mullingar, Co. Westmeath and associated works. The proposal will comprise of solar modules on a 10° mounting system which will be connected to 3 phase inverters.

These works are located within the curtilage of 2 (no.) protected structures; former prison Governor's House and adjacent buildings, Mullingar Gaol (County Buildings) RPS Reference Number 019 089 and Site of Mullingar Gaol (County Buildings) RPS Reference Number 019 090 and are contained within an Architectural Conservation Area.
